Local health departments are expected to purchase drugs at the lowest available pricing. The Federal 340B Drug Pricing Program requires drug manufacturers to provide outpatient drugs to eligible health care organizations/covered entities at significantly reduced prices which are generally recognized as the cheapest available. This program enables covered entities to stretch scarce federal and state resources as far as possible, reaching more eligible patients and providing more comprehensive services. Local health department clinics which diagnose and treat sexually transmitted diseases and receive funding from state and local resources are 340B STD covered entities.

The following drugs are approved for purchase by Local Health Departments for providing STD services within their agency:
